### **Our Mission:**

To provide high quality education in an open and friendly environment where students can develop and achieve the skills required to be successful contributors in their community.

# Sprucewood School

We are a k-12 school with an enrolment of 36 students. 56% of our students are female and 44% are male. Our instructional staff consists of approximately 2.57 full time teachers and 1.43 Educational Assistants. Divisional resource staff and clinicians make regular visits to our school. Students in grade 9 - 12 take most of their courses via ITV. Some courses are taught locally.

To improve Math literacy, especially mental math skills, of students in all grades.

<u>Goal:</u> 65% of students in Grades 1-8 will be at their Grade level according to the *Diagnostic Interview* 

### Actions:

- Teachers will assess student progress and inform the students about it.
- Students will develop independence as they gain confidence in their mental math skills.
- Students will be able to apply their mental math skills to their daily math activities.
- -Jump Math used in younger Grades
- -emphasis on the Mental Math component for each grade
- -emphasis on real life math in older grades

## Measurement:

- -daily math assignment weekly tests (Grades 6-8)
- -Diagnostic Interview
- -report card mark (3 or greater)

# To improve literacy in reading, specifically comprehension, for all grades.

Goal: 80% of the students in Grades 1-8 will be reading at or above Grade level with comprehension according to Fontas and Pinell testing by the end of May 2017

### Actions:

- Teachers will conference with individual students to assess and monitor student progress.
- -Home reading program
- -Fontas Pinell levels will be recorded during first report card time and in May
- -Grades 1-8 with participate in a school wide Guided Reading time
- -Grades 1-8 will be following a Daily 5 style format
- -The school will utilize RAZ kids and Vocabulary (Grade 1-5)
- -Grade 1-8 will use Words Their Way
- -Grades 6-8 will use Reading Apprenticeship strategies
- Comprehension strategies will be focused upon and specifically taught in Language Arts classes

### Measurment:

-May Fontas and Pinell

To enhance the sense of Belonging and School Community for all stakeholders.

Goal: 80% of students will display a sense of belonging and citizenship in the school setting

### Actions:

- There will be a greater effort to emphasize the importance of group effort and a group result.
- The school will emphasize on Excellence in the following 5 character traits: Respect, Responsibility, Honesty, Self-Control, Kindness
- Weekly assemblies will occur where the whole school reviews/does an activity based on one of the traits.
- Common language between classes, teachers, and playground.
- -implementation of Empathy building activities, behaviours suggested by Michele Borba
